



In one year **Right2Water**, the umbrella campaign for water charge protest, has become the biggest protest movement the state has ever seen. Hundreds of thousands of people have peacefully and successfully used the campaign to give expression to their human Right2Water. This campaign is a winning campaign and the Government's plans in relation to Irish Water are in tatters. Their privatisation agenda has been exposed and rejected. But how many of you also share a vision of a fairer more equal Ireland?

The Right2Water Trade Union's sponsored a ground up consultation process of the water movement earlier this year and together we have identified 10 policy principle areas. Those principles are now published and could potentially provide a programme for a future Government; one that could deliver a fairer, more equal Ireland that benefits the many, and not the few. Some of the policies identified include:

Right2Water Irish Water PLC would be abolished in the first 100 days of Government and a Constitutional Referendum that would guarantee our water in public ownership forever

Right2Housing Housing should be treated as a basic human right with a State obligation to seriously tackle homelessness through significant investment

Right2Health Access to quality healthcare should not be dependent on income. The long-standing policy of promoting and incentivising the private healthcare industry is inefficient and discriminatory against those on low incomes

Right2Education The provision of education should be truly free – without the necessity for 'voluntary contributions' – up to at least primary degree level
